Welcome back to the final half term of the year. Goodness me the year has flown by and the builders are still with us and due to delays with materials and staffing issues are likely to be with us through the Summer Holidays. The new completion date is in August so I am hoping that this will be ready for the start of the new academic year.

On Monday, the CLASS team have organised a fabulous treat for the children. The whole school from Reception upwards are going to the Castle Theatre to watch a film. They will be leaving school to walk over just before 10:00am and will return for lunchtime. This is being fully funded by the CLASS team and all down to the amazing contributions that you have all made over the year so thank you. The Castle have informed us that the film "Sing 2" does have some flashing/flickering lights so please make us aware if you feel this will be an issue for your child.

This week saw us start the Wizard of Oz rehearsals. You should all have received a letter regarding this. The slip does need to be returned so we know that you are aware of the costume requirements which unless you are told otherwise is :

- A plain green T-Shirt ( The Newton one can be worn )
- Denim - shorts, skirts , trousers, dungarees - in blue
- Trainers /plimsolls

Every child is taking part and we will send further information about the performance and tickets etc for each of the performances which we are expecting all of the children to be involved in.

It has been such a long time since we were able to do this and we hope to follow on from our previous successes of " Joseph " and the "Lion King". I think it is going to be an amazing end to the School Year.

I wanted to just give you a reminder regarding our absence procedure. We should have three contacts on your child's record that we hold. If your child is unwell please leave a message on the answer phone telling us their name, class and reason for absence. Please do not tell us they are "sick" as that will require us to phone for clarification. If you do not contact us by 9:30am we will start to ring down the list of contacts that you have provided us with. If we have no response we will then visit the home address. This is all part of our safeguarding processes as parents legally have to ensure that their child attends school and we expect at least 95% attendance across the year.

We write to you regularly so you are aware of any issues with regards to attendance and also we examine late arrival to school these letters follow our monthly attendance meetings. We track every child's attendance and following this tracking you may receive a letter if we feel there is a problem. The gate opens at 8:40am which is the start time of the school day. Children are marked late once the gate is closed. When you look at lateness to school it does cause an issue for children. They miss the start of the day, there is work for them to complete and conversations with staff to settle them into the school environment , the schedule of the day is shared and explained and at 9:00am we all move to the hall for collective worship. It is very embarrassing for children to have to walk into the hall when the whole school is already there listening to the adult leading worship .



This is a good time of year to check your child's contacts and ensure that you have three . You can access the details via the app "SIMS Parent". If you are not already registered on SIMS Parent, please look out for an email or pop in to the office. If you have already registered, please take the time to confirm that all of the details we hold for you are correct.

Some of you I am sure are starting to think about school uniform and getting yourself prepared for September. A few reminders:

- Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 all need to wear a white shirt either short or long sleeved with a tie.
- Years Reception,
- 1 and 2 can either wear a polo T - shirt with no tie or a white shirt and tie.
- grey or navy , skirt, trousers , pinafore (NO BLACK) with a school jumper or cardigan . All shoes should be black no trainers
- PE is navy shorts or joggers with the school T - Shirt in their house team.

**Please note that bags of any kind are not allowed, only for Year 6, children should be using a book bag.**

Items are available to buy at the [Uniform Shop](#) in Wellingborough on Olympic Way - PE T-shirt, PE sweatshirt, School jumper/cardigan and book bag. Please also remember that CLASS run a nearly new uniform shop that has some brilliant bargains.

### Headlice

We have had reports of Headlice in the following classes: Year 1 and Year 5.

Please ensure that you are regularly checking your child's hair and we would suggest that especially if your child is in these year groups, you comb through their hair thoroughly and treat if necessary.

Please work with us to keep the spread of headlice down and report to us if your child has them

- ✓ **Head lice** aren't pleasant, but they are **harmless**
- ✓ You can only catch them through **head-to-head contact** with an infested person
- ✓ **Detection combing** should be carried out **every week**
- ✓ If **live head lice** are found, buy an **effective treatment** and treat all infected family members at the same time
- ✓ If **no head lice** are found, make sure you **prevent head lice** by avoiding head-to-head contact, and use Lyclear Repellent when there is a reported outbreak


