Please remember to book your FLRM it is vital that we see as many of you as possible. A fabulous week in school with many visitors and events showing everyone that All Saints is the best !!

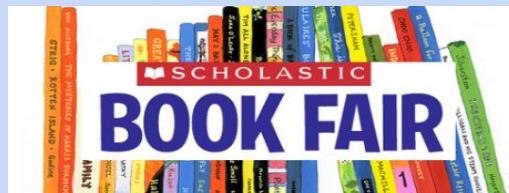

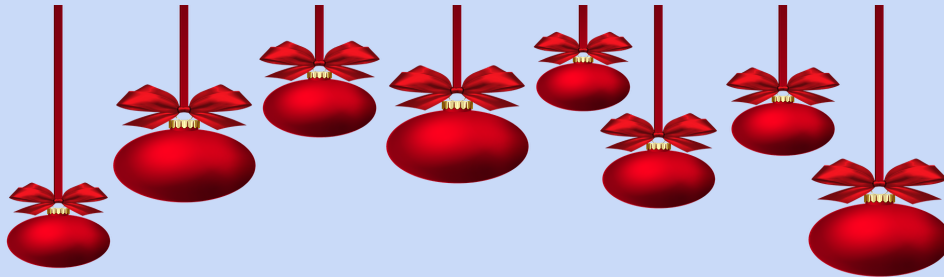
