The end of a busy week with the children finding themselves involved in many exciting learning opportunities connected to our new theme of "From Horse to Horse Power". I do hope that you are all able to rearrange things so you can attend and thank you for your support in this matter.

Our clubs have all been up and running this week and I am particularly excited about the special group of children that are working with Mr Wintle and Mr Sanderson in preparation for our participation in the "Big Bang" competition at Silverstone. Two teams of children have been created to enter the science, engineering, maths and technology competition with a project/invention using some of our new lego equipment. Another very popular club is homework club run by Mrs Dady. The purpose of this session is for the children to complete their homework supported by Mrs Dady and/or using our IT equipment , therefore can you please ensure that your child does bring their homework with them to the session. Hotshots (Basketball) and Pacesetters (dodgeball, gymnastics) have both carried out taster sessions with the children this week so remember to sign up for these if your child is interested or you wish to go on a waiting list for a place.
