What a lovely week we have had in school . The children have coped with the changing weather very well and embraced the Newton Charity day fully with many participating in the wearing pink theme. Thank you to everyone who has purchased items supporting Chelsea's Angels which is a fabulous charity and one that works so hard locally to support families.

In the mornings we open the gate at 8.30 and the doors at 8.40. The majority of children are in their classrooms working at 8.45 until 9.00 when we all move to the hall for assembly. The gate is closed at 8.50. The majority of children are receiving 5 times 15 minutes of learning which over the week adds up to one hour 15 minutes. Unfortunately there is a group of children who are consistently late and have to arrive at the Reception area to be signed in, these children are missing out on learning, they disrupt others when they arrive into the classroom late and they can be very embarrassed. It is essential that children arrive on time and a good habit to get into for later life. Please try to ensure that your child gets to school before the gate closes ideally to enter school at 8.40 am.

Safeguarding and ensuring that All Saints provides a safe and secure environment for the children and staff is essential. Some of the steps we take are:

- Secure site
- Visitor sign in

Security the gates should always be shut unless manned by a member of staff. In the mornings Mrs Richardson and/or myself are always out on the gate. We use this as an opportunity to welcome everyone and to catch up with parents however the real underlying reason is to ensure that we are monitoring who is entering the school site. The hall doors are opened by a member of staff again to welcome the children but also to ensure that no one enters the building without our knowledge. At the end of the school day the gate is manned by Mrs Richardson and/or myself to ensure that no child leaves the school site without an adult. On a Friday at Stay and Share and other events when adults are within the building they are all signed in so we have a record which would also used in the event of fire. When visiting the school site within the day or calling at the office please shut the gate after yourself.

The front door does not close fully unless pulled shut so again when entering please do not allow it to just close behind you, you must push it .

Visitor Sign in all visitors have to sign in at the office and receive a pass which is displayed

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in a layard around the visitors neck. If the person is visiting for the first time they must show photo ID to verify their identity and if they are going to work with children without full supervision from a member of staff they have to show their DBS (Disclosure and Barring Service) . A DBS is a certificate which screens the adult for any form of criminal offence that may have happened at any time and all of us that work or volunteer in the school have one in place.

It is vital that you ensure that you sign in with either an adult or at the office and that you ensure that the main gate is always shut.

Thank you for your supporting this very important aspect of school life.

This weekend I look forward to attending the Northampton Town and MK Dons football match with Mr Hunter, Head Boy and Girl Harry and Izzy and Eithan Hemeng as we collect the Gold TAMhs award. This award recognises the work that the whole school does in supporting children and families with the wide range of mental health issues that may occur, ranging from dealing with bereavement to poor sleeping, low self esteem and anger management to name a few. I look forward to sharing some photos with you next week.

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Calling All Knitters! – Children, Mum’s, Dad’s, Grandparents

For the service to celebrate the 150th anniversary of the consecration of All Saints Church, 20th May 2018, there is an ambition to cover the pillars in a riot of knitted, coloured flowers. To achieve the desired look hundreds of flowers will be needed and we at All Saints CEVA Primary would like to make our contribution. The more people who can make a few the more we can give!



The pattern is below, it is simple so even beginners should be able to have a go. Flowers are required for the beginning of May at the church, but they can be sent into school at any time and we will collect them here.

- Cast on 120 Stitches
- Knit 4 rows
- Next row. Slip 1, knit 2 together, pass slip stitch over – repeat until the end of the row (40 stitches)
- Next row. Knit 2 together – repeat until the end of the row (20 stitches)
- Knit 4 rows
- Next row. Knit 2 together – repeat until end of row (10 stitches)
- Cut of wool, thread through remaining stitches and pull tight. Slip stitch the edges together.

They can be any colour, and any size yarn – remember to use a needle size appropriate to your yarn thickness.

Forest Schools
